# Competitive League League Rules

## **League Overview**

- This is a maximum 12-team, open-format, competitive league
- Teams can be from <u>any</u> club
- Team member/spares <u>must a registered, active playing member of a curling club</u> throughout the curling season of play
- Playing format (round robin, playoffs etc) to be determined annually at the beginning of the curling season
- Unless otherwise advised, games will be played on Wednesday evenings at 7:30pm
- Entry fees will be advised at registration and are due in full by November 15<sup>th</sup> latest
- All teams registered in the current season will be considered as entered in the league for the next season, <u>subject to their confirmation by Aug. 15<sup>th</sup></u> prior to start-up. Failure to confirm by the Aug. 15<sup>th</sup> target date will see the team replaced with a fill team

### **Rules of Play**

- Unless otherwise noted, Canadian Curling Association rules of curling for general play will apply, notably......a) the '5-rock Free Guard Zone rule' and b)'new' & effective with the 2021-22 season, the use of compliant broom heads
- All games will be 8 ends
- This is a win/loss league. Playing format to be advised annually

### **Player Substitution**

- This is an open competitive league, therefore there are no regulations or limitations on the eligibility, positions, or number of spares used each week, as long as a team has at least three players participating for the entire game
- A list of spares will be made available to teams; you recruit your own spares
- If for some reason a team is unable to field a team for a league game, we ask the team
  to give the opposing team's skip as much notice as possible of the game cancellation.
  Affected teams are to coordinate their own make-up games to be played at the
  convenience of available ice and time at any club. Failure to play the make-up game
  before the start of playoffs will see the non-offending team be determined as the
  winner
